What is available? Individual grant amounts averaging \$300

Who may apply? Teachers and staff of the North Kitsap School District.

What to submit? Original and two copies of the Mini-Grant Application. Applications are available at school offices and on our website for downloading.

Where to submit?

When to submit?

Applications must be postmarked by midnight **Saturday, November 7, 2009.**

The intent of this NKSF grant program is to provide funding for innovative and creative learning opportunities unfunded by other means.

Evaluation factors are: originality, number of students benefited, multi-year impact, and quality of the application. The Grants Committee of the North Kitsap Schools Foundation will review and score all applications. This committee is comprised of lay people as well as educators so all information should be clear and concise. Applicants will be notified of results by November 20, 2009.

Guidelines:

Repeat requests for previously awarded projects by same teachers will not be allowed.

Applications by teachers for projects awarded to other teachers previously will be considered.

Grant recipients are required to provide a short report to NKSF after completion of the project, or initiate a classroom visit from a representative of NKSF. The report can be sent by email to contact@nkschoolsfoundation.org. Recipients must complete a report or visit prior to being considered for future grants.

Not funded: Teacher release time, teacher salaries, staff training, capital improvement costs, incentives or rewards and food not related to grant goals.
